- Is there special significance to the sequence of readings? No, nothing is meant by the sequence.
- Is this list of texts complete? No, other texts could be added.
- Once you have done this "month of devotions," what next? Do another month of devotion from this collection. Repeat and reuse.
- Are these texts the canon within the canon? No. Nevertheless, this is a
 handy list which points to the heart of Scripture. You may want to mark
 these verses in your Bible.
